



Snow White in 4 ply!

Two sizes, 6 to 18 months or 2 to 3 years

To fit 6-18 months 2-3 years

MATERIALS:

Patons Beehive Fingering 4 ply

Patonised or

× 1 oz. balls 3 3

Patons Carefree Canadiana Fingering 4 ply

You must use the Patons brands recommended above to be sure of a successful result.

Two No. 9 BEEHIVE needles, measured by BEEHIVE gauge, or MILWARDS DISC needles.

Tension

14 sts. and 18 rows to two square inches on No. 9 needles, measured over stocking stitch.

This Hat has been specially designed for the size range given and it is regretted that no other adaptations are available.

Cast on 72 [80] sts.

Proceed in loop patt. as follows:—

1st row—K.

2nd row—K.1, * make loop by inserting point of right-hand needle into next st. and winding yarn/wool over point of needle and first finger of left-hand twice, then over the needle, then draw loops through st. leaving st. on needle, place the 3 loops back on to left-hand needle and knit the 3 loops and st. together through back of loops, rep. from *, K.1.

These 2 rows form the patt.

Continue in patt. until work measures 4½ [5½] ins, from beg., finishing at end of a 2nd row.

Keeping patt. correct shape crown as follows:—

1st row—(K.6, K.2 tog.) 9 [10] times.

2nd and alt. rows—Patt. all across.

3rd row—(K.5, K.2 tog.) 9 [10] times.

5th row—(K.4, K.2 tog.) 9 [10] times.

7th row—(K.3, K.2 tog.) 9 [10] times.

9th row—(K.2, K.2 tog.) 9 [10] times.

11th row—(K.1, K.2 tog.) 9 [10] times.

13th row—(K.2 tog.) 9 [10] times, (9 [10] sts.).

Break off yarn/wool. Thread through remaining sts., draw up and fasten off securely.

TO MAKE UP

Using a flat seam, join seam.
